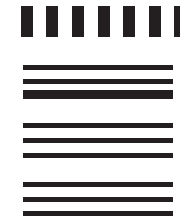

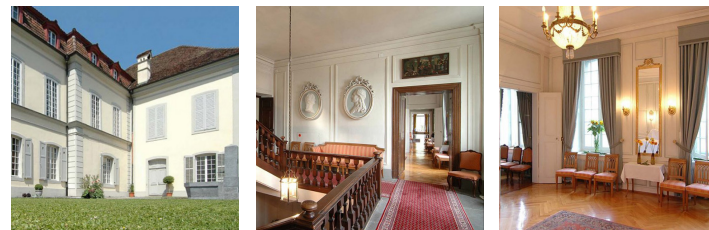

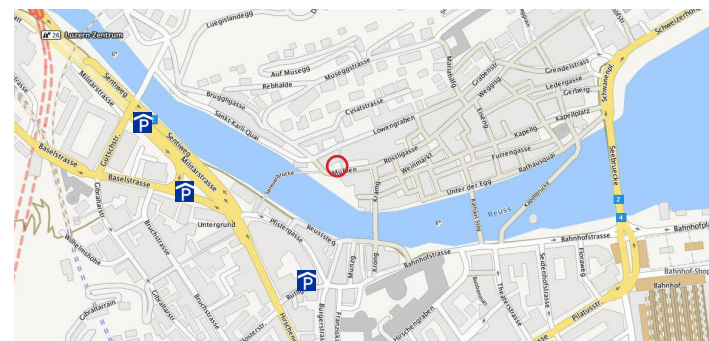

The talks of **Mina Popovic** on mosaicism in embryos were award-winning at the ESHRE 2017. In the light of the new legislation in Switzerland, this is an important topic for us all.

Individualisation and personalisation are future topics. But how can ovarian stimulation be adjusted properly? Most people would rely on AMH. But **Leif Bungum** has proved that AMH not only fluctuates within cycles but also between them.

As I have done in recent years, I will close the symposium with important news from 2017 and 2018 that is of interest for our field.

I am looking forward to welcoming you to this exciting event and hope you accept my invitation to the Fourth Lucerne Fertility Symposium.
